Additional Information(Review of the fellowship/Special requirements if overseas/etc):  Excellent fellowship for post-CCT plastic surgeons. There are 5 different units that offer this fellowship.  In Hull I was involved in 113 cosmetic operation. I attended 26 GA theatre lists and 35 aesthetic OPDs. I was first assistant. There was no independent operating. I was able to visit lots of surgeons up and down the country who performed surgery in areas I was particularly interested.  Each fellowship comes with the option to visit Greg Williams in Manchester and London and see some hair transplantation.  Important information: Bursary is £8000 paid in three instalments. As you are post-CCT and not attached to an NHS hospital you must seek separate indemnity – each agency offers widely different prices so must choose wisely. Check with each unit that offers the fellowship what are the operating days and times as often they work weekends. This has implications for travel.
