Additional Information (Review of the fellowship/Special requirements if overseas/etc):

It is expected that the fellow will have been supervised in a minimum of 100 microsurgical cases by the end of a 12 month fellowship. 70% of cases will be breast reconstruction, 25% head and neck reconstruction, and 5% facial palsy and skin oncology.

Fellows have been appointed from both the UK and overseas, and should demonstrate a commitment to a career in microsurgical reconstruction. Fellows will lead on inpatient management, delivering the weekly journal club, research projects and formal student teaching, and also assist on the FRCS (Plast) exam course every six months.
